1. **Background:**

At Mangliya location Ferrous and Non-Ferrous Scrap has got accumulated. Hence, this note is being put up for floating online forward auction for disposal of this scrap at Mangliya Location.

2. Proposal: Disposal auction-key points

a. Estimated Values, Start Price and Incremental values :

Estimated rates as per Government Approved Valuer for disposal of the used oil the only single lot is enclosed as **Annexure-I**.

Total estimated value of disposal is Rs. 151,000.00/- (Exclusive of taxes). Refer In-House Estimate **Annexure-II**.

1. Online Auction

The sale will be through online auction only. Once bids submitted are given during the online auction, they cannot be revised downwards which may kindly be noted.

- 1) Participation in e-auction will mean that the party has inspected the facilities / materials / lots / nos. available for sale / disposal at site as per auction details in Table-A [Part-1] on as is where is and no complaint basis and fully satisfied / understood the lot details and site conditions himself regarding the condition, size, quantity, quality, weight, numbers etc. of the items available for sale / disposal.
- 2) No claim shall be entertained in case of any variations in quantities particularly on down ward side or condition / quality / quantity/ weight / numbers of the materials etc. at the time of upliftment which may kindly be noted.
- 3) There can be only one H-1 bidder per lot / item at any given time. If more than one bidder bid, same value for an item / lot, the bidder who quotes the highest price first as per the server time is considered as the H-1 bidder for that lot / item.
- 4) M/s. C1 India Pvt Ltd shall be our E auctioneer for the subject e-auction.

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2. Earnest Money Deposit (EMD):

Interested bidders who submit the required documents as stated in Clause 4 will be given a Virtual Acount Number (VAN) once BPCL Customer/Vendor code is created. EMD payment shall be done by the bidder through NEFT/RTGS mode of transfer against this VAN and the proof of payment shall be submitted to BPCL.

The EMDs not received at BPCL by due date & time will not be considered for auction. Any delay in receipt of EMD will not be considered.

 Unless Earnest Money Deposit is paid through NEFT/RTGS to the VAN, acknowledged 'Special Terms & Conditions', Annexures A & B and filled and signed Annexures for Customer Code creation are submitted to BPCL in advance, as per schedule, participation is not allowed.

- 2) For participating at our e-Auction, the intending bidders shall pay refundable Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) by NEFT/RTGS as mentioned against each Category mentioned in Table–A [Part–1] on or before **5:00 PM on 05.03.2025**. No interest is payable for the deposit amount held by us.
- 3) The EMD payments of unsuccessful bidders shall be returned by NEFT without any interest subsequently within 6 weeks approximate. No interest will be payable for such refunds. In case of any undue delay in refund of cheque due to unforeseen reasons at BPCL end or due to any postal/courier delays BPCL is not liable for any claims of interest or any disputes arising out of this. - 4) The successful party will be advised the outcome of the e-auction result by issuing a letter of allotment within a reasonable time, i.e. 1 month approximate after the e- auction after getting internal approvals. The successful party's EMD will be refunded only on completion of the job to the full satisfaction of the Corporation & submission of No claim certificate. 3. Description of Materials and Quality and Quantity:

- 1. The materials shall be disposed off in "AS-IS-WHERE-IS" and "NO COMPLAINT" basis as per unit mentioned such as MT, Lot, and No etc.
- 2. The Buyer must uplift the declared quantity within prescribed time limits(02 weeks) as mentioned in sale order.
- 3. The sale/disposal offer may be withdrawn by the seller any time and the decision of the seller in this regard is final and binding on all.

5. Auction Result:

- 1. Auction Result will be declared subject to confirmation from BPCL. The result will be declared within 2 weeks approximate from the date of Auction.
- 2. The rate offered by the bidder shall be considered as Basic Price per Unit of the items mentioned or per lot price as mentioned in the e auction. All taxes, Duties, GST, TCS or any other statutory levies or taxes as applicable under the relevant GST act / IT Act or any other act shall be charged extra at the rate prevailing at the time of sale

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letter/delivery/invoicing. At the time of receipt of payment towards sale of scrap items as mentioned in the tender documents, GST @ 18% will be charged along with 1% TCS. Same shall be adjusted at the time of final invoicing; accordingly differential amount if any shall be refunded / recovered from the customers. No interest claims shall be entertained by BPCL on account of advance receipt from the customers.

- 3. The present tentative rate of GST is given In Table "A" [Part -2]. However, these Taxes, as applicable shall be on actuals. Tax Collection at Source [TCS] @1% of [basic value+GST] will be charged extra to all Bidders for all items. Successful bidder has to deposit the amount of equal to [basic + GST + TCS]. BPCL would provide Tax Collection Certificate to successful Bidder. In case, TCS is not applicable bidder can take refund from appropriate authority based on TCS Certificate of BPCL.
- 4. Please note that taxes/duties, TCS etc. statutory levies shall be as applicable at the time of sale letter / upliftment / invoicing. Decision is in regard to applicability of GST/TCS rates etc. as decided by BPCL would be final and binding to the successful bidder and bidders cannot claim/dispute on this matter.
- 5. Any failure to accept the rate of taxes/duties/TCS etc. as may be indicated by BPCL in the sale letter/ at the time of upliftment / in the invoice, BPCL reserves the right to forfeit EMD and cancel sale letter without assigning any reasons.
- 6. In case successful bidder wants to take lube oil of Maharashtra state, NOC from MPCB shall obrained by bidder. BPCL shall provide required documents/authorization for obtaining NOC. Successful bidder shall do all the required follow up with pollution control board of destination state & cost of the same shall be factored in bidding.

Bidding screen:

- 1. The start bid price & increment price have been mentioned vide Table-A (Part-1) which shall be visible to all the bidders on the irrespective bidding screen for each Lot for which they are qualified to bid. Please note that the first bid that comes in the system should be equal to the start price + one increment or higher than the increment value for each Lot. The second online bid and onwards for any particular Lot will have to be higher than the H1 rate by the minimum increment value, or higher than the increment value.
- 2. Please note that the start bid price is the minimum basic price excluding all taxes etc and bidders have to put their bids above the start bid price indicated above. BPCL reserves the right not to sell at the highest offer received during the auction in case their expected reserve / target price is not achieved or for any other reasons.
- 3. Bidders to note that Start Bid Price provided by BPCL is only to proceed with start of e-auction. It is to be noted that Start Bid Price is not considered as expected sale price. Customers who are interested to purchase the material are requested to give their best price for the material even in case where there are no competitive bids. BPCL reserves to sell material only when sale price obtained is as per BPCL requirement. Also please

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note that the Start Price mentioned is only indicative and can be changed on the auction day, based on market conditions.

7. Payment & Delivery:

- Successful Bidder [H-1 Party] will have to make payment of full Sale value [including GST and TCS as applicable] by NEFT/RTGS Transfer into the Virtual Account Number created for the successful bidder, within 2 weeks of Sales order / intimation of bid acceptance and uplift the materials by making their own arrangements within 2 weeks of sale Invoice issued by BPCL.
- 2. In case of any delay, prior intimation needs to be sent to BPCL authorities and concurrence should be sought. In case where there is no intimation from the customer or the customer does not respond to the follow-ups then the following steps may be taken by BPCL:
- 3. Party's EMD will be forfeited.
- 4. Sale letter will be treated as cancelled and Seller shall have the right to dispose off the materials. No claim whatsoever from the said party shall be entertained.
- 5. The party may also be debarred from participation in any future sales / auctions for one vear.
- 6. The party may also be debarred from participation in any future sales/auctions in line with BPCL's Holiday listing Policy.
- 7. Bidders must ensure that the inspection of scrap items at location is carried out thoroughly before quoting in auction. Common understanding on quantity of scrap items has to be reached before the bidder submits the bid. No claims will be entertained post bidding and at the time of lifting the material. In case of any dispute the matter should be resolved directly with the location.
- 8. Bidders who will not honor the sale Letter / Authority letter or submit forged/ fake documents shall be put on holiday list in line with BPCL's holiday listing policy as mentioned in the link: https://www.bharatpetroleum.com/images/files/holidaylistingpolicyfinal.pdf
- 9. The other broad guidelines for the period of holiday listing based on the circumstances under which the bidders can be put on holiday listing are mentioned in the above link. Clause 4.2.12, page no8, Sr.no.10 of the holiday listing policy of the above link to be read as "withdraws / revises the bid downwards after becoming the H1 bidder"

Note that:

EMD will be refunded after completion of the disposal activity on submission of No Claim Certificate (NCC) within a period of 6 weeks.

Successful party has to make payment in full and in one installment only in cases where unit is lot. No part payments will be allowed.

However in case of arising/ call off basis, payment is to be made for call off quantity.

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8. Removal of Materials:

- 1. The Buyer will employ his own labor and means; at his own cost and risk for removal/collection/shifting of scrap items, segregation in case it is required as per schedules and payment of wages/compensation to the laborers will be the sole responsibility of the buyer. The buyer shall ensure that his workmen do not loiter around within the stores area of the factory. They shall not touch any material except those materials shown to them and he will be solely responsible for ensuring that material being loaded is as per his sale order. BPCL reserves the right to stop any material from being uplifted if it is disposed off /planned to be disposed off separately or is a part of other tender/sale order, BPCL decision will be final and binding. Irrespective of the condition of the lube oil, choice of quantity, quality shall not be criteria for upliftment, Buyer will have to uplift the same as directed by BPCL. For ongoing sale orders, buyer allotted the sale order in the present tender will be allowed to uplift the balance material after the upliftment of material under existing sale orders. Buyer will have to load as per priority as decided by BPCL w.r.t. the area/items/location, as per BPCL instruction buyer will plan loading accordingly. They shall not be involved in any malpractice/ misconduct in BPCL premises. If any of his workmen is even found violating these restrictions as per BPCL rules & regulations as a buyer, the buyer shall be responsible for making good the loss to the owners on which their decision shall be final and binding. Any discrepancy observed after truck is left the site, the responsibility of discrepancy shall lie with buyer and buyer shall be answerable for any queries/justification required by BPCL. Such discrepancy shall be considered as misconduct on the part of buyer and BPCL can take suitable action as deemed fit against such buyer.
- 2. The buyer shall complete the transaction including collecting the lube oil before 4.00 PM on any working day with prior appointment with the concerned department within the stipulated delivery days. The items offered for sale will be handed over to the successful tenderer by BPCL official at site on production of our Authority Letter which will be issued after the payment of total sale price including Taxes & TCS etc.
- 3. The Seller reserves the right to unload the vehicles for inspection purpose. If it is suspected at any time that the buyer has loaded the material /materials for which he is not buyer or if the buyer is found to carry excess material than that mentioned in the documents, the company will be within its right to detain the truck, unload the goods at the cost & expenses of the buyer & terminate the contract forthwith and forfeit the EMD, sale value & claim such further losses and damages that may be caused to the Seller.
- 4. Any damage to the Seller's or Third Party's properties within Seller's premises during removal of the items will have to be made good by the successful buyer at their own cost. The Seller reserves the right to claim from the buyer any expenses which might have been incurred by it over and above the EMD by way of restoring damages caused to properties belonging to the Seller/Third Parties by the action of such buyer or their men. Until such losses are reimbursed, delivery of the material sold will not be given to the buyer.

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- 5. Loading / Unloading will be carried out by the buyer at his own costs & risk. All material handling machines/equipment's, tools and tackles, labor, etc. or any other items as may be required to be supplied by party or as insisted by the seller for successful completion of the job will be arranged by the buyers at their own cost. Non-availability of the same will not be considered as a ground for 'Late-Lifting' of the materials. Vehicle used for lifting material should comply all Maharashtra motor vehicle rules, 1989.
- 6. Vehicle used for transportation of hazardous waste shall meet criteria mentioned in hazardous waste & other waste (management & transboundary amendments rule, 2019.)
- 7. For material sold on "call-off & arising basis", BPCL will issue call-off as & when required. However in case BPCL does not issue call off within three months of last upliftment date of previous call off, the sale order shall be treated as closed & EMD Refund shall be processed in such case. The execution period of the sale order shall be maximum of one year duration.

9. Decision in case of disputes:

1. In case of any dispute regarding the contract, the decision of the Seller shall be final and binding. If there is any dispute as to the last or highest bid or dispute in identifying the item belonging to particular lot, the dispute shall be determined by the Seller and their decision shall be final and binding to all.

10. Right of Acceptance/Rejection of offer:

- 2. The Seller reserves the right to withdraw wholly or partially any or all the items set for sale at any time during the period of contract without assigning any reasons.
- 3. The goods are sold subject to the reserve /expected price obtained by the Seller to their satisfaction. The Seller reserves the right to reject any conditional offers.

11. Forfeiture of Earnest Money Deposit:

- 1. In case of failure of the buyer to comply with the conditions of the tender / contract, the Seller may at its discretion, terminate the contract and the EMD paid by the buyer will stand forfeited for the breach of contract by the buyer. The lot in question will be re-sold by the Seller, without any reference to the buyer, to any other buyer.
- 2. The lots paid for must be completely removed at the buyer's expense within the schedule period specified. If any lot is not removed within this specified period, the Seller may re-sell / re-auction the said lot or portion thereof. The EMD of the lot will stand forfeited in the event of the buyer not removing the lots within the specified time. The party may also be debarred from participating in any future sales/ auctions in line with BPCL's Holiday listing policy. The party may also be debarred from participating in any future sales / auctions in line with BPCL'S Holiday Listing policy.
- 3. In case the bidder backs out from any of the LOT mentioned in which he is H1 bidder, then the complete EMD amount submitted for that Category will be forfeited by BPCL.

12. Termination of Contract:

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The Seller reserves the right to terminate the contract at any time by giving 'three days' notice on the following ground.

- 1. Unsatisfactory execution or performance of the contract by the buyer.
- 2. For improper behavior of the buyer or breach of the terms and conditions of the contract.
- 3. Decision of the Seller to terminate the contract shall be final and binding and no claim for damages and compensation shall be entertained. In the event of the buyer or his agent or servant committing or attempting to commit theft, fraud, dishonesty or gross misbehavior in connection with the subject matter of this contract or in any other connection whatsoever concerning the business of the Seller, the Seller will be entitled to terminate the contract forthwith and forfeit the EMD/Sale Value at its sole discretion.
- 4. In case of any incomplete job, or only part job done before the schedule time for completion, and if the delays are found to be attributable to the buyer's failures, the seller, i.e. BPCL if not satisfied with their performance, reserves the right to terminate the contract and award the job to any other Contractor at their cost and risk.

13. Passing of Property In the goods:

It is expressly made clear that the property in the goods whether sold by units, weights or lots, whether arranged or otherwise, will remain that of the Seller and will pass on to the buyer only when material is taken out by the Buyer from the factory Premises after getting valid dispatch documents. The Seller-BPCL is not responsible for any issues/disputes after the material is taken out by the Buyer from the factory Premises.

14. General:

- 1. All Safety Regulations shall be followed by the buyer and their men in removing the items. Also the buyer and their men will be neither allowed to carry lighters nor to smoke inside the premises. They should obtain suitable Work Permits / Safety Certificates for excavation, hot work etc. from the authorities at site in case it is required. The work in such cases will be allowed to carry out during working hours of the IPS Mangliya Pipelines. The work should be commenced only after obtaining necessary permission from the Corporation's representative. The workers employed to carry out the work should observe the Corporation's rules and regulations at the respective places. Successful buyer shall provide necessary personal protective equipment (PPE) to all its workman deployed for scrap loading.
- 2. Basic /minimum PPE such as safety shoes, helmet, hand gloves & overcoat/ apron are must. Cost towards this shall be borne by buyer. Apart from this, in case any additional safety equipment suggested by BPCL safety department in the interest of job/ safety of workman, shall be provided by buyer for safe loading. Utmost care to be taken to avoid any incident/ accident. Job shall be carried out safely.

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- 3. Any injuries to workers employed by the successful buyer while removal / transport of the items and any risk / liabilities (including under Workmen's Compensation Act etc.) arising out of the same, will be the liability of the buyer and not of the Corporation. The Buyer should also indemnify the Corporation against all liabilities / demurrage claims arising out of non-compliance by the buyer of all statutory requirements currently in force or made applicable subsequently. The successful buyer will keep the Corporation indemnified against all damages / claims arising of the aforesaid.
- 4. All notices, letters sent to the buyer shall be deemed to have been received by him / them within 48 hours from the time of posting if the same are sent at the address given by the buyer. In case of any email communication, it shall be deemed to have been received immediately after it is sent on bidder's E mail address registered with BPCL.


